## **Project Information to Gather**

Here is a list of the project information you will need to compile:

- Project Area(s) map
- Regional map showing Project Areas
- Proof of ownership of land, or if LPI is not the landowner, an Agreement to Transfer Credits from the landowner
- Planting design and quantification method:
  - Single Tree for trees planted at least 10 feet apart, for street trees, dispersed, or linear-type design
    - If so, need GPS or inventory of trees planted
  - Clustered for trees planted at least 10 feet apart but relatively contiguous or near each other to create canopy, i.e. park-like settings
    - If so, need to show imaging of trees
  - Area Reforestation for trees planted closer than 10 feet apart, in an area greater than
     5 acres with to create canopy and a forest ecosystem
    - If so, need to show imaging of trees
- Tree species
- Numbers of trees planted
- Quantification info will depend on the planting design above (CFC will provide more detail)
- Documents showing trees planted invoices from nurseries, photos of plantings, signed statements from planting partners (CRTI will provide more detail)
- Maintenance information
- Documents as described below



# **CFC Planting Project Document Checklist**

The "CFC Planting Project Document Checklist" is provided as a way to help track when various project documents are due, when they are submitted for review, and when they are approved. It also outlines each individual planting project document with the purpose of the document and notes with additional information.
